## Declarations

Declarations for your senior project topics are posted throughout the high school. They look great. Please try to find the time to look at the different project topics. Many of the parents that came for conferences enjoyed reading them.

## I—Search Paper

Parts 1 and 2 of your I—Search papers must meet proficiency before you start to write part 3. Part 3—Research and Application includes all your primary research found in articles, journals, and books with the proper citations. This section also includes your interview with an expert in your field. This is the longest section of your paper. You may need to revise this section many times in order to meet proficiency. Expect to spend most of your time on this section.

Be sure to submit your drafts of these two sections to your seminar leaders **before due dates in calendar** so you can make revisions as necessary. Also, the expert you interview probably has a busy schedule so make sure you schedule your interview in a timely manner.

When you are citing your sources, you must also include a *Works Cited* section as the last page of your I—Search Paper. Your handbook contains examples of how to cite sources and how to format the *Works Cited* section.
