## Senior Project Portfolios

If your portfolio does not meet proficiency, you are not allowed to complete the oral presentation component of your project on Thursday, May 27th. Any senior that is not eligible to present on May 27th is not eligible to participate in any graduation week activities.

The 180th day of school is the day scheduled for oral presentations for any senior who is not eligible to present on May 27th. Senior Project is not offered in summer school. You must successfully complete a senior project by the 180th school day.

### Letters of Recommendation
